Thomas Keesecker retired in 2019 after serving as a church musician for over 40 years in Lutheran and Roman Catholic parishes in Virginia, Montana, and Maryland. His sacred music is published by MorningStar, Augsburg Fortress, Choristers Guild, Concordia, and GIA. His studies at the Berklee College of Music in Boston and the Catholic University School of Music in Washington, D.C. prepared him for a career in which he has mixed classical technique and jazz improvisation. He also has a love for Celtic and folk music. Besides being a new Grandpa, he travels the country sharing his piano music in informal concerts which incorporate hymn singing, stories, and poetry.

Thomas Keesecker will share music from his piano collections published by MorningStar Music. His first piano collection was published in 2017, his tenth collection will be published in 2023. His music may be listened to on Amazon Music and YouTube. A reception will follow the concert.
